

VICE PRESIDENT

The vice president shall perform the duties of the president upon the absence, resignation or disability of the president. Upon the absence, resignation or disability of both the president and vice president, the clerk shall perform the president's duties.

The vice president shall:

1. Represent the Board upon the request of the president.
2. Consult with the Board president and the Superintendent on the preparation of board meeting agendas.
3. Perform such other duties as assigned by a majority of the Board.

The term of office of vice president shall be one year commencing immediately upon election and ending with the election of the successor to the office.

Should the office of president become vacant, the vice president shall become president of the Board of the remainder of the unexpired term.
