Mr. Sol Chooljian expressed his concern that community members will be asked to support another bond when they were told the Measure H Bond was going to be used to build two new schools but only one has been built, RCHS.

9. ACTION ITEMS

A. Consideration of Approval to Award Contract to Isom Advisors for Financial Advisory Services -General Obligation Bond The District is in the process of creating a long-term facilities master plan that will prioritize facility improvements and identify the funding sources available for updating facilities and for new construction projects. On February 14, 2018, the Board of Trustees voted 5-0 to seek solicit qualifications and proposals for Financial Advisory Services – General Obligation Bonds. The District received three proposals and interviewed each Fianacial Advisory Services firms and District Administration determined that Isom Advisors is best suited to achieve the District's financial goals.

Mr. Albaugh clarified the fees for services, stated that charges will incur at the time of bond sales and the contract terms will be for five years with the option to renew for one year; it will be presented for approval at the next Board meeting. Trustees confirmed that there is still a balance in Measure H and that all bonds have been sold and Mr. Albaugh affirmed this. Dr. DeLeon added that no contractual agreement can last longer than five years without Board approval.

10. STAFF REPORTS A. General Obligation Bond – Measure A Update

On January 17, 2018, the Board of Trustees of Oxnard Union High School District passed Resolution 18-01 on a 5-0 vote ordering an election to authorize the issuance of school bonds. District staff timely submitted the filing paperwork with the County of Ventura Election's Office for the June 5, 2018 election. The District received notification from the County of Ventura Election's Office that Oxnard Union High School District's school bond will be Measure A on the June 5, 2018 ballot. The District staff will update the Board on the election process.

Trustees asked who the point person will be for this item. Mr. Albaugh replied that he and Dr. DeLeon are working collaboratively on this.

B. Oxnard-Area High School #8 Site Plan Update – WLC Architects

The District has engaged the services of WLC Architects to design Oxnard-Area High School #8. WLC has completed a site design and continues to modify the plans as part of the approval process with the CDE, DSA and City of Oxnard. Mr. Bob Hensley and Ms. Karla Alonzo DeLeon provided Trustees an update on the project and recommended modifications form the CDE, DSA and City of Oxnard.

Trustees asked if the timeline for the building of the new school is decreased will it increase the cost of the school and this was affirmed. Trustees requested further updates as plans progress. Trustees expressed their safety concerns and requested that WLC Architects plan for enhanced security for this site. Trustees addressed their concern for sustainable, green, items during the designing phase, a list of community members the architects are conferring with for their input on the designing of the school and the possible traffic conjection resolution that may occur on Camino del Sol Street.

President Davis called for a break at 7:25pm. The meeting reconvened at 7:35pm.

The District has been moving multiple facility projects forward this year including a Facilities Master Plan, the Oxnard Area Growth High School, a general obligation bond, and other facility projects. District staff and PMSM Architects will provide an informational workshop designed to update the Board and prioritize the list of projects for the Facilities Master Plan; provide a funding review of local and state resources available to the district; and establish preliminary timelines for project planning and implementation.

Mr. Albaugh informed Trustees of the funding sources available and the amounts in each source to be used for modernization plans and New Oxnard Area HS #8. Trustees asked what is included, allowable projects, in modernization. Trustees requested to be informed how much bond money will be allotted per school, what the District budget plan will look like for the projects and a priority list with the rationale for each item. Trustees also requested a specific plan for modernization eligibility; how much money will the District put up and when the funding is expected to be reimbursed back to the District. Trustees agreed that modernization and safety are the most important at this time. Trustees requested that if any items need repair now and there is funding available to be sure these items are brought to the March 14th Board meeting for approval. Trustees requested to see what the input is from stakeholders.
