## 8. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORTS

General Report:

Superintendent Gabe Soumakian, Ed.D., announced that recognition of students and staff had just concluded in the Pacifica High School Performing Arts Center Board and the Board was returning to open session. He reported on the following activities.

- Condor and Frontier graduations services are scheduled for tomorrow at 2 p.m., all other sites will hold grad services at 2 p.m. on Friday, with the exception of PHS at 6 p.m.
- The first session of Summer School begins June 17 and second session after July 4<sup>th</sup> holiday; each session is three weeks long.
- District and site staff are working to ensure that students are prepared to receive instruction on the first day of school on August 28. With the initiation of "Taking Care of Business Week" students and parents will receive information in a timely manner such as class schedules, locator cards, and instructional materials.
- It is anticipated that the Governor will soon sign a budget and that OUHSD will receive \$3 million; the district will have two years to spend the money and is working on a plan on how the funds will be utilized.

10. Trustee López Hanson reported she met with a group of concerned parents and staff and said it was a good opportunity to listen and hear what they had to say, and she attended the presentation on Learning Management System.
