- 8-A Regular Report:

Student Representative to the Board of Trustees, Daniel T. Galang reported that all schools are busily preparing for Homecoming, Pacifica held a talent show, Rio Mesa is celebrating Hispanic Heritage week, and he stated the students from ODC will contribute their ideas for the District's Goals and Priorities list.

8-B Board Introduction: Adolfo
Camarillo High School, Visiting
Students from Germany

William E. Dabbs, Jr., Assistant Superintendent-Business Services was pleased to introduce Ms. Heidi Graves, GAPP Coordinator from Camarillo High School. Ms. Graves was pleased to report that several foreign exchange students from Germany were visiting the school through the GAPP program. She reported students have been site-seeing, participating in several field trips, and have especially enjoyed attending school activities such as homecoming. Ms. Graves invited the Board and administrative staff to the October 19 Kaffee Klatsch at Camarillo High School.

8-C Board Updates:

- Randy Winton, Assistant Superintendent-Business Services distributed a
 Project Schedule for the Camarillo Magnet High School and Performing
 Arts Center provided by HMC Architects. Dr. Soumakian reported
 weekly meetings will be held with administrative staff to keep abreast of
 the project's development and stated he would like to accelerate the
 process and see the project completed by May 2015.
- Mr. Dabbs was pleased to report that out of 16,000+ students, less than 40 students in the District have not yet complied with TDAP requirements. Every school site has the names of the students who have not completed this process and will contact students as soon as possible.
- Dr. Soumakian announced that prior to tonight's regular meeting, a
 Special Board meeting was held to discuss the Blueprint for Greatness.
 Administrative Staff and the Board made good progress in finalizing the
 District's Goals and Priorities to achieve greatness. The final product
 will be presented at the Board Meeting of October 26 for board-approval.
- Dr. Soumakian reported staff is reviewing student data information systems that he feels will propel us into the next generation of data analysis.
- Dr. Soumakian informed Trustees staff is going to look at providing staff and the public agenda online to streamline our system to move the District towards the 21st Century.

He suggested a ribbon-cutting ceremony be held for the Solar Panel Projects at the sites; this would be a great way for the District to receive publicity.
