AUDIENCE TO ADDRESS THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES: A speaker addressed the Board to advocate for the students of Adolfo Camarillo and asked Trustees to consider the needs of the students when making decisions.

A speaker addressed the Board regarding the food services fraudulent claims and requested reemployment with the District.

Deputy district director for LULAC requested that Board meetings be simulcast in Spanish.

A speaker spoke on behalf of the students of ACHS requesting that the District keep the 77 acres and make use of the property when it is needed, and recommended the District proceed with renovations to the school.

A speaker stated he concurred with Principal Lipman and requested the Board enhance ACHS and save the 77 acreage for the future.

AUDIENCE TO ADDRESS THE BOARD – Continued:

A teacher and coach from ACHS stated there is nothing mediocre about Adolfo Camarillo and requested Trustees approve the construction projects for the school in order to keep our kids from the Camarillo community in Camarillo.

A board candidate stated the timing of the proposed projects at ACHS is suspect due to the upcoming election, building a magnet school in Oxnard and Camarillo would benefit both communities, the facilities plan did not reflect renovations to schools, and based on a survey, 84% of the Camarillo community would like to have a new high school in Camarillo.

A teacher from ACHS stated Measure H money should be used to improve the infrastructure at ACHS.

A speaker disagreed with the direction the Board has taken and requested the Board to go back to their original commitment to build a school in Camarillo.

A representative from the American Cancer Society commended and thanked Joe Finn, Lead Grounds Maintenance Worker at Oxnard High for his dedication and hard work. Mr. Finn helped A.C.S. with the recent fundraiser held at OHS and thanks to Mr. Finn, Relay for Life was one of the most successful fundraisers in Ventura County.

A speaker addressed the Board to request that Measure H funds be used to make the much needed improvements to ACHS, the speaker stated there are not enough students to accommodate a new high school in Camarillo, and requested the Board move forward with the plans to construct a PAC and Academy at ACHS.

The Principal of Adolfo Camarillo thanked the Board for their continued support and reported ACHS is in the final stages for the CSBA Golden Bell Award. He asked the Board to consider spending Bond money on the venues at ACHS. He stated large venues will affect many families in the city of Camarillo and with the additional facilities, ACHS students will be able to compete with the surrounding schools that have large venues on their campuses.

The ACHS athletic director stated he was proud of the Camarillo community and felt the need to express the affection and appreciation for all the schools in the District. He stated it was time to give the community the kind of facilities it deserves, times change and needs change, right now is the opportunity to give the students the facilities they deserve and he asked the Board to seize the opportunity to do something wonderful for the Camarillo community.

A speaker stated the Broad promised Camarillo a new high school and the door is open right now, to follow through with the recommendations made by the design committee and move forward with a new high school and do what is right for the Camarillo community.

A speaker stated the ACHS campus has been ignored and now is the time to modernize and upgrade the campus. The momentum is good, keep the ball rolling and keep improving Cam High.

A candidate for the board of trustees and resident of Camarillo asked the Board to reconsider taking action on improvements to ACHS, to not ignore the needs of one school over the other, and requested that two schools be built, one in Oxnard and one in Camarillo. The speaker requested that a consent calendar item be moved to action.

A speaker requested that a new school be built in Camarillo, to follow the recommendation of the educational design committee and do what is specified under Measure H.

A representative from OFTSE requested the Board follow what was mandated by the voting public when Measure H was passed and build a state of the art facility on the District's 77 acre property.

A speaker addressed the Board advocating for improvements to ACHS, student numbers are down and the current students' needs should be considered. Build a Palley Pavilion style PAC for ACHS.

A speaker addressed the Board to address the food services fraudulent claims and asked how the claims would be paid.

A speaker addressed the Board to express concerns regarding a consent item, requested a copy of a contract, and asked why a particular contract was chosen.

A student from HHS thanked board candidates for attending the board candidate forum and stated the district should expect great things to happen at Hueneme High School.

A speaker requested that two consent items be pulled and asked why a particular architect was selected.

A speaker addressed the Board to express concerns regarding the decisions made by the Board for Camarillo High School.

A parent of students at ACHS stated ACHS is a fantastic school, renovations to the school are needed, build the PAC, and offered suggestions for the use of the 77 acres.

A member of the Measure H Bond Committee stated the public is misinformed regarding the usage of Measure H money. The speaker stated the District does not have to build two schools and to follow the State-mandated guidelines, build a school where there is a need.

A speaker expressed concerns regarding four consent items, the Oversight Bond Committee and change orders.

Trustee López Hanson stated that letters had been given to her by parents of Camarillo requesting that the letters be read at the meeting. Letters were in favor of building a new high school in Camarillo, names of the parents were made public.

Letter one: Build a new high school in Camarillo; the mass exodus of students from ACHS unacceptable.

Letter five: Build a new high school in Camarillo; use Measure H funds; promise to build in Camarillo remains unfulfilled.

Letter six: Build a new high school in Camarillo it is time for Camarillo to get the facilities which are rightly deserved.

Letter seven: A definite "yes" for a new high school in Camarillo so that students can attend a high school in their community.

Letter eight: Build a new high school in Camarillo; property taxes are going towards building schools in Oxnard.

Letters nine and ten: Build a performing arts center and pool at ACHS.

Trustee Stocks stated that Trustee López Hanson violated the District's Board Policy910 by not sharing letters with Trustees prior to the meeting.

Superintendent Carter stated the opening of school was excellent and came about due to the hard work of the principals and staff. Dr. Carter commended staff and thanked them for their efforts.

Superintendent Carter informed Trustees that the 2009-2010 Accomplishments for individual schools would be posted on the web sites. He extended compliments to the principals for the outstanding results and for a job well done last year; outstanding accomplishments and results!

Superintendent Carter reported that during the press conference he did not have an opportunity to speak to the issue of repayment because it was under investigation and the federal government is still working on their investigation. He clarified the repayments would not have an effect on the construction of facilities, opined there would be no effect on salaries, and clarified the district was not aware of the repayment schedule and the district's recommendation would be to extend the schedule over a period of time. He commended the Board for taking the initiative to move forward with the investigation.

Superintendent Carter stated that since July 2009, the Board and the public have received facilities updates at almost every Board meeting via slide shows and written presentations.

Mr. McFarland provided a PowerPoint presentation on the various district and school site projects under construction, and he reported nineteen facilities projects have been completed.

Superintendent's Recommendation:

 Recommendation Regarding School Facilities in City of Camarillo A speaker addressed the Board to express his support for the construction projects at ACHS; specifically the location of the PAC at ACHS. The speaker opined building the PAC away from the campus would cause students lose valuable instructional time traveling from one school site to the other.

Superintendent Carter recommended the facility upgrades at ACHS to bring the school up to the standards of Pacifica and Oxnard high schools. He stated at this time, he could not recommend building a school on the 77 acres. It was his opinion that a small academy on the 77 acres would take away from the needs of Adolfo Camarillo, and it was the right thing to do at this time, improve the facilities for the students at ACHS.
